
The Board wishes all our residents a Happy and Safe Holiday and a Happy and Healthy New Year.

APARTMENT HEAT



Building owners are legally required to provide heat to their tenants. Heat must be provided between October 1st and May 31st, i.e., "Heat Season," under the following conditions:

Day

Between the hours of 6:00 AM and 10:00 PM, if the outside temperature falls below 55 degrees, the inside temperature is required to be at least 68 degrees Fahrenheit.

Night

Between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM, the inside temperature is required to be at least 62 degrees Fahrenheit.

We have been getting many calls regarding the heat in the apartments. According to the US Energy statistics, we are meeting the guidelines for providing heat to our residents. Please note that if you still have your air-conditioners in the window without being covered, this will have an impact on the temperature of your apartment.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

If you notice excess air humidity in your apartment or hear hissing sounds from your radiators, please email Carlos at *superberkeley@gmail.com* as soon as possible. These events are signs that the air values in one or more radiators in your apartment may need to be replaced. If you have one or more leaky values and they are not replaced, it could cause damage to the walls and ceilings of your apartment, cause ceiling and wall leaks in the apartments beneath your apartment and could cause structural damage to the building facade.
