Purpose: To provide a venue and opportunity for Berkeley residents to gather and socialize.

Meetings: “BerkSocials” will be held on the last Friday of every month. If the Friday happens to fall on a holiday, the co-chairs may designate another date for the monthly meeting.

Where: Berkeley Community Room

Time: 7:00 – 10:00 PM

Guidelines/Policies:

1. BerkSocials are open to all adult Berkeley residents
2. There is no fee for the use of the Community Room because the Club’s purpose is for the benefit of Berkeley residents
3. Residents from 78th Street and 35th Avenue can access the 77th Street basement by using the interior garden entrance in 77th Street. There is a combination lock on the door for easy access to the basement.
4. The Board does not fund – or reimburse individuals for items purchased – the Club’s activities. All activities are financed through donations
5. Attendees must be respectful of all individuals in attendance
6. Residents can bring any board game they wish to play with fellow residents
7. Residents supply their beverages and snacks; co-chairs will provide tea and popcorn
8. Small prizes for Bingo winners will be given
9. The co-chairs will set up the game and refreshment tables.
10. Community Room must be cleaned up at the end of every social gathering. Attendees are responsible for the cleaning up and breaking down of the tables and chairs they use before leaving the Community Room.
