Thank you to Marina, Ted, Michael, Katherine and Kayhan for getting this accomplished. Stephen mentioned that Starbucks will donate free coffee grounds for gardening compost. If you are interested Stephen can help you to do that.	PLEASE put all emptied compost bags in the seed room.
