Clothing Bring down to the white re-fashioNYC container in a sealed plastic bag

**Private Papers** Bring down to wheeled black shredding bin, remove staples

Glass/Metal

Place in the blue bin in the incinerator room, no plastic bag

**No light bulbs.** These can be carefully discarded in the trash. Consumer take-back programs exist for fluorescent bulbs and CFLs.
